Blue Farm takes its name from the farmhouse at Anne Moller-Racke's home, and vineyard, in Carneros. In 2001, Anne planted seven acres of Pinot Noir divided into three blocks dedicated to the Swan clone and three Dijon clones. The Dijon 115 contributes perfume and power; the Swan fills the wine's middle, adding body and textural layers and the Dijon 667 and 777 lend stucture. Together they produce one complete wine from the Anne Katherina vineyard.
