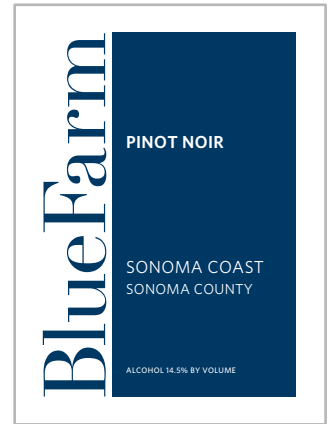

The Vintage

The 2024 vintage is the product of an even, mild season that brought all components into balance, yielding exceptional complexity, texture, and depth. Rainfall was normal at 24 inches in Carneros. Flowering occurred on schedule in mid- to late May, and warm weather continued through June and July, leading to even veraison. Harvest began in late August with our Laceroni Pinot Noir and Chardonnay in Russian River Valley. A few days of heat around Labor Day carried the remaining vineyards to the finish line. By mid-September, all fruit was in, making for a remarkably smooth harvest. The 2024s are lush and elegant, showing beautifully now while holding excellent aging potential of 10 years or more.
